



## Job Announcement Wildland Firefighter/Mitigation Crew Member

Elk Creek Fire Protection District is now accepting applications for **Wildland Firefighters/Mitigation Crewmembers**. The general responsibilities of this position include; wildfire response (local and national) as part of a wildfire module on wildland engines; and manual fuel reduction. While assigned to fires, crew members may be assigned for up to 30 days out of area. Crew members will be expected to work 16 hour days in arduous conditions. When assigned to mitigation projects, crew members will cut trees and brush, burn piles, masticate and/or chip.

Salary range is \$15.00 to \$18.00 DOQ. Position is eligible for overtime (possibly extensive) and pay incentives.

Applications must be received no later than 5:00pm on February 28 2019.
